ENTRY FEES: \$30 pre-registration for each competitor for one division and each kata team, \$25 for each additional division. Please send all pre-registration entry forms and checks to Mike Woodson, 310 S. Elm St., Denton, TX 76201, postmarked no later than April 29, 2011. \$40 at the door for each competitor for each division and each kata team on the day of the event, regardless of number of divisions entered. Make checks payable to DJOJ or Denton Jr. Optimist Judo.

SPECTATOR'S FEE: Ages 6 - 16 is \$1.00; Ages 17+ is \$2.00 (Below 6, no fee).

WEIGH-IN: (at tournament site)

- Friday - All divisions 7:00 to 8:00 pm
- Saturday - 8:00 to 9:00 am, Masters and Kata Registration
- Saturday – 8:00 to 9:30 am, Juniors and Youth
- Saturday – 9:30 am to 12:00 pm, All Others

RULES: Current IJF Modified.

- Choking prohibited for Junior competitors who are under 13 years of age.
- Arm bars prohibited for all Junior competition.
- Arm bars prohibited for all Novice competition.
- **All competitors are required to provide their own white and blue belts.** All competitors must have at least a white gi. A match between two blue gis will not be permitted.

WEIGHT CLASSES: (* Five minute Matches, ** Three Minute Matches)

- * **Senior Men:** 132, 145, 161, 178, 198, 220, 220+
- * **Senior Women:** 114, 125, 139, 154, 172, 172+
- ** **Novice Men** (Green Belt and Below): 132, 145, 161, 178, 198, 220, 220+
- ** **Novice Women** (Green Belt and Below): Divisions to be determined after weigh-ins.
- ** **Men and Women Masters:** Divisions to be determined after weigh-ins.
- ** **Men and Women Youth:** Divisions to be determined after weigh-ins.
- ** **Junior Players:** Will be grouped in two-year age groups, starting with 5 and 6 year olds, up to 15 and 16. Age groups will divide by weight, as required for the safety of the competitors (as many groups as required). Competitors may be moved up to the next age, with permission from the parents, coaches and tournament director.
- ** **Men and Women Novice Masters:** Divisions to be determined after weigh-in. This is a division for those beginning players whose age would allow them to play in the Masters' division, but who rank might ordinarily deter them. To qualify, the player must be above the age of 30, and be below Brown Belt in rank.

Youth division available to players who are under the age of 20 on the day of the competition. Players under the age of 17 will be allowed to enter, but only with the permission of their coach and parents, and the tournament directors. Youth division players will be permitted to compete in any other division, in which they are eligible (i.e., Junior or Senior).

All competitors in Youth and Senior divisions will compete using Senior rules (i.e., arm bars and chokes) regardless of their ages.

Kata competition as required by TJI All Star Rules: Nage No and Katame No, for both Senior and Junior players. (Additional kata may be added).

AWARDS FOR MOSE WOODSON CLASSIC: Trophy for 1st, 2nd and 3rd. All other Junior players will receive a participation medal. Junior and Senior Team Trophies to be awarded to the clubs with the most points (First = 3 points, Second = 2 points, Third = 1 point).

ELIGIBILITY: All contestants must be active members in good standing of the USJI, USJA or USJF. Application for USJI membership may be made at the tournament. Only competitors with a rank of Sankyū and above will be permitted to compete in the Senior Divisions. Only competitors below Sankyū will be permitted to compete in the Novice Divisions.

Junior competitors who hold the rank of Blue Belt (or above) and who are at least 13 years old may compete in the Senior Division. Junior competitors who hold a rank below Blue Belt and who are at least 13 years old may compete in the Senior Novice Division.

NOTE: ARM BARS ARE PROHIBITED IN ALL NOVICE DIVISIONS!!!

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way, including travel to and from, the combined 2011 MOSE WOODSON CLASSIC and related events and activities of the United States Judo, Inc., United States Judo Federation, United States Judo Association, Texas Judo, Inc., the Denton Jr. Optimist Judo Club, the Denton Noon Optimist Club and the University of North Texas, the Board of Regents of the University of North Texas, the State of Texas, their officers, servants, agents or employees, I hereby

1. Acknowledge that I am familiar with the sport of Judo and understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
2. Agree that, prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions, and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor and/or a tournament official to such condition(s) and refuse to participate.
3. Acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, including permanent disability or death, and severe social and economic loss due to not only my own actions, inaction or negligence, but also to the actions, inaction, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability or death.
5. Release, waive and discharge and covenant not to sue the United States Judo Inc., United States Judo Federation, United States Judo Association, Texas Judo, Inc., the Denton Jr. Optimist Judo Club, the Denton Noon Optimist Club, and the University of North Texas, the Board of Regents of the University of North Texas, the State of Texas together with their affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, officers, agents, coaches and other employees or volunteers of the organization, event officials, medical personnel, other participants, their parents, guardian(s), supervisors and coaches, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners, lessors and lessees of premises used to conduct the event, all of whom are hereinafter referred to as "releasee" from any and all claims, demands, losses, or damages on account injury, including permanent disability and death and damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence or the releasee or otherwise to the fullest extent permitted by law.
